

# FREDONIA ACCEPTED STUDENT CHECKLIST



- SUBMIT YOUR DEPOSIT**  
Your \$100 deposit reserves your space in the Class of 2021. The deposit covers your housing deposit (\$50) and your admissions deposit (\$50). You can pay your deposit right online at [fredonia.edu/deposit](http://fredonia.edu/deposit). The deposit deadline is May 1, 2017.
- UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPT YOUR FINANCIAL AID**  
All students who have completed a FAFSA and are accepted to Fredonia will receive a Financial Aid Award Letter. This letter outlines the financial assistance (loans, grants, scholarships, etc.) available to you at Fredonia. Please follow the instructions on the Award Letter to accept/decline your aid and complete the necessary loan requirements such as the e-MPN and Entrance Counseling or Financial Aid Verification. Questions regarding this process can be directed to the Office of Financial Aid at (716) 673-3253.
- COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING SURVEY**  
Once your deposit is processed, you will be instructed to complete your housing survey online through Your Connection. This survey allows you to rank your preferences, and identify roommate requests. - LOG-IN TO YOUR FREDMail ACCOUNT**  
Once your deposit is processed, a FREDMail account will be created for you. You can find your log-in credentials in Your Connection. When you reach the main menu page of Your Connection, click on the "View Your User IDs and Passwords" link located under Personal Information. Listed below your Fredonia ID, you will see your eServices UserID and Password. These log-in credentials are used to access your FREDMail.
- COMPLETE COURSE SELECTION SURVEY**  
All students must complete the course selection survey on Your Connection. This will assist the Registrar's Office to create your course schedule for the fall semester. Schedule adjustments can be made at Summer Orientation.
- COMPLETE YOUR HEALTH HISTORY FORM AND IMMUNIZATION RECORD**  
All students must send in their Health History Form and Immunization Record to the LoGrasso Health Center prior to August 1, 2017. We encourage all students to have a baseline physical done by their physician or pediatrician prior to coming to Fredonia. If this physical has been done, please send a copy along with the health form and immunization record. To download the form, please visit <http://www.fredonia.edu/healthcenter/incomingstudents.asp>. Students must return this form and a copy of their immunization record by mail or fax to the Health Center or bring these forms to Summer Orientation.
- SEND FINAL TRANSCRIPTS, ADVANCED CREDIT & COLLEGE CREDIT COURSEWORK**  
We must receive final transcripts showing successful completion of your current studies. First-year transcript requests are sent directly from their high school. You will also want to send any AP, IB, CLEP or college coursework you have completed in High School. Official college transcripts and test scores can be addressed directly to the Registrar's Office, Reed Library, State University of New York at Fredonia, Fredonia, NY 14063.
- ATTEND SUMMER ORIENTATION**  
During Summer Orientation, your Fall 2017 schedule will be finalized with a specially trained academic advisor. After June 15<sup>th</sup>, a tentative schedule will be available for you to preview on Your Connection. In addition, you will become familiar with the campus, available services, and learning tools to help you succeed in your academic career at Fredonia.
