

FREDONIA ACCEPTED STUDENT CHECKLIST



- SUBMIT YOUR DEPOSIT**

The deposit covers your housing deposit (\$50) and your admissions deposit (\$50). You can pay your deposit right online at fredonia.edu/deposit. The deposit deadline is June 1, 2017.
- UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPT YOUR FINANCIAL AID**

All students who have completed a FAFSA and are accepted to Fredonia will receive a Financial Aid Award Letter. This letter outlines the financial assistance (loans, grants, scholarships, etc.) available to you at Fredonia. Please follow the instructions on the Award Letter to accept/decline your aid and complete the necessary loan requirements such as the e-MPN and Entrance Counseling or Financial Aid Verification. - COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING SURVEY (if planning to live on campus)**

Once your deposit is processed, you will be instructed to complete your housing survey online through Your Connection. This survey allows you to rank your preferences, and identify roommate requests. - LOG-IN TO YOUR FREDMail ACCOUNT**

Once your deposit is processed, a FREDMail account will be created for you. You can find your log-in credentials in Your Connection. When you reach the main menu page of Your Connection, click on the "View Your User IDs and Passwords" link located under Personal Information. Listed below your Fredonia ID, you will see your eServices UserID and Password. These log-in credentials are used to access your FREDMail.
- VIEW YOUR TRANSFER EVALUATION**

Approximately three weeks after your acceptance, a Transcript Evaluation will be available for you to view online. To view your evaluation of credit, log on to Your Connection. Your login credentials are your Fredonia ID and Pin. From there, you can go to the Admissions Applicant tab and "View Your Transfer Credits".
- COMPLETE YOUR HEALTH HISTORY FORM AND IMMUNIZATION RECORD**

All students must send in their Health History Form and Immunization Record to the LoGrasso Health Center prior to August 1, 2017. We encourage all students to have a baseline physical done by their physician or pediatrician prior to coming to Fredonia. If this physical has been done, please send a copy along with the health form and immunization record. To download the form, please visit <http://www.fredonia.edu/healthcenter/incomingstudents.asp>. Students must return this form and a copy of their immunization record by mail or fax to the Health Center or bring these forms to Summer Orientation.
- COURSE REGISTRATION**

To simplify the registration process, your first semester schedule is built for you based on the college credit you have accumulated. Once your deposit is submitted, the process of building your schedule will begin. To view your schedule, log-in to Your Connection and click "View Student Schedule."
PRIORITY REGISTRATION* - Those students that deposit by **March 31, 2017** can take advantage of Fredonia's Priority Registration Program. This allows you to register for your classes at the same time as our current students.
- ATTEND SUMMER ORIENTATION**

During Summer Orientation, your Fall 2017 schedule will be finalized with a specially trained academic advisor. In addition, you will become familiar with the campus, available services, and learning tools to help you succeed in your academic career at Fredonia.
