# **Experienced Leadership Development for Upperclassmen**

#### The Leadership Minor

The minor in Leadership Studies is an interdisciplinary program created with substantial student input. It requires 21 credit hours of coursework and practicum credit. The program is designed to provide intensive study of leadership, complimented by co-curricular activities provided through Student Affairs.

#### Goals of the Minor

- To introduce leadership as a recognized and well-documented set of concepts gleaned from designated texts that enhance leadership study
- To provide the opportunity for an internship experience
- To allow students to use this minor to compliment a variety of major programs

#### Requirements for the Minor

- Undergraduate student enrolled at Fredonia
- Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Application, consultation, and approval with current Academic Advisor

Coursework focuses on five basic components: theory of leadership development; leadership in a changing world; communication skills (oral and written); techniques for working with groups and organizations; and presentation skills. The minor includes a required internship, scheduled in consultation with the program coordinator.
